

How to Set-up VoiceMeeter so you control when TeamSpeak/Discord Sound goes to your Stream

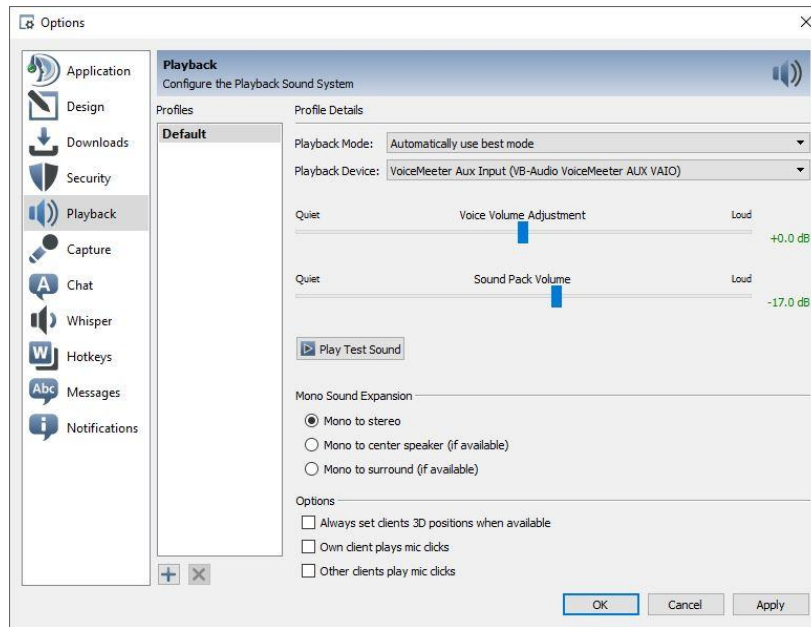
Ok, so I use a program called [Banana VoiceMeeter](#). It's a software Mixer that lets me control various inputs and allows me greater control of what goes out to my Stream.



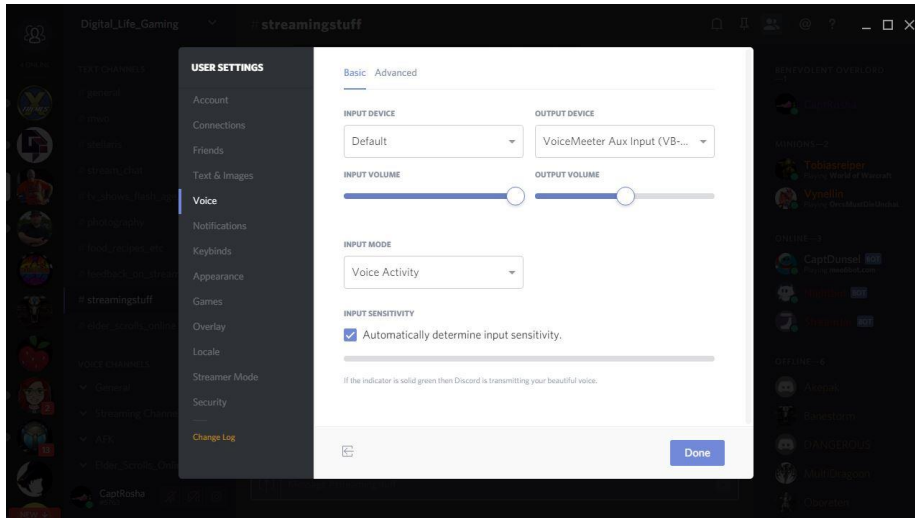
It can handle 3 Hardware Inputs and then 2 Virtual Inputs. The Hardware inputs I use are for Microphones. I have a Blue Snowball and a Headset mic. For Virtual Inputs, one I use for my general computer sounds (Youtube, PC, Game, etc,) and the other I specifically use for TeamSpeak.

You also have 3 Hardware Outs (A1-A3) and 2 Virtual Outputs (B1-B2). I only use 1 hardware out and 1 virtual out. A1 is my headset and then B1 is to the Stream.

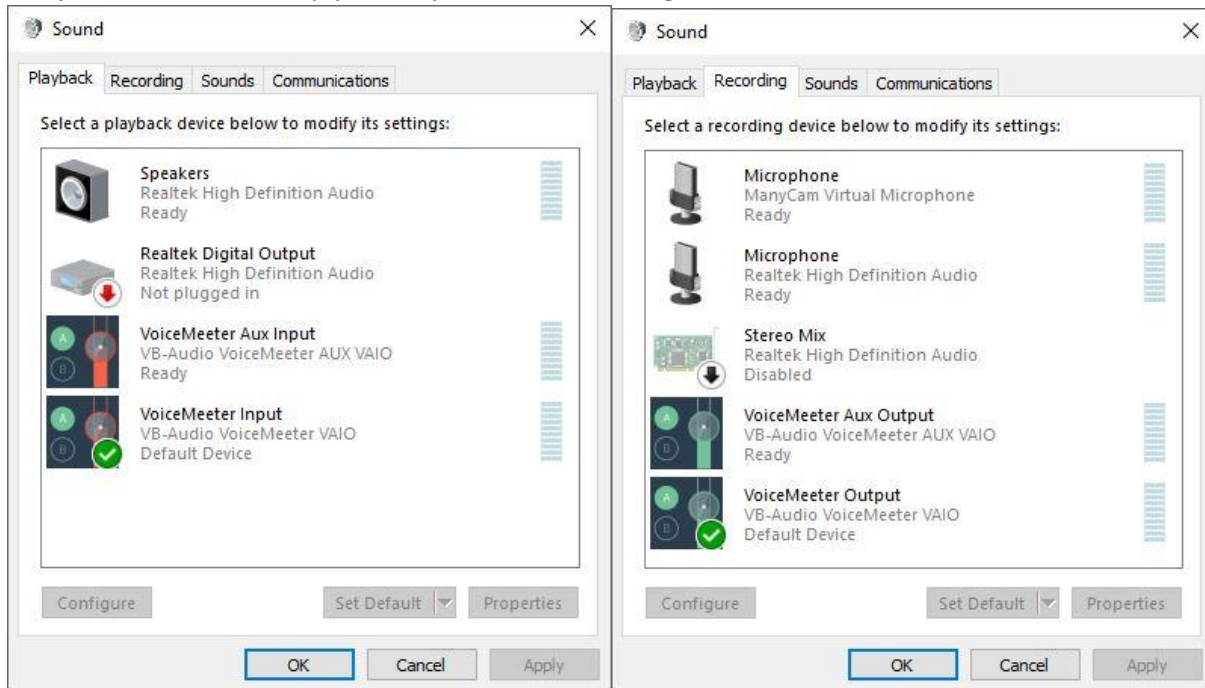
Of course, this means I needed to set up TeamSpeak to use the Playback Device as VoiceMeeter Aux Input.



You can also set-up Discord to use this as well. (click on Voice, Change Output Device as below)



Oh, you also need to setup your Playback and Recording Device in Windows to use VoiceMeeter.



Then it's simply clicking B1 off or On Under VoiceMeeter VAIO AUX to turn TeamSpeak off from your stream. Now, if you are using Discord, same thing, just set your Discord to use VoiceMeeter VAIO AUX as its playback device and it will work the same way.
